Chairperson Pieh opened the Public Hearing at 5:00 p.m.

The public was asked for comments on the Extension.

Harold Schramm stated that the key issue is "retail."

Selectman Marsh advised he would abstain from voting on this issue.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was vote 2 to 1, with one Selectman abstaining, to approve the Extension of Moratorium Ordinance on Retail Marijuana Establishments and Retail Marijuana Stores and Retail Marijuana Clubs for an additional 180 days until January 5, 2018.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to adjourn the Public Hearing at 5:06 p.m.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept the Land Use Ordinance from the Bremen Planning Board for public hearing and vote by the Town.

Walter Voskian indicated that the Ordinance Review Committee worked an additional three months to finalize the Land Use Ordinance, after the initial Town vote on 4/01/2017. They had considered all public comments before finalization.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to conduct a Public Hearing and Town vote on the Land Use Ordinance on July 20, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.




