SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 21, 2016

The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 4:15 pm.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go into Executive Session at 4:36 pm pursuant to 1 MRSA § 405(6)(A) for personnel matters.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go out of Executive Session at 4:50 pm pursuant to 1 MRSA § 405(6)(A) for personnel matters.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go into Executive Session at 4:52 pm pursuant to 1 MRSA § 405(6)(E) for legal matters.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go out of Executive Session at 5:35 pm pursuant to 1 MRSA § 405(6)(E) for legal matters.

The Public Hearing on the Amendments to the Traffic and Parking Ordinance began at 5:05 pm.

Selectman Nevins reviewed the Amendments to the Traffic and Parking Ordinance with the public. No comments were made.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to enact the Amendments to the Traffic and Parking Ordinance dated January 21, 2016.

The Selectmen reviewed the Carpenter Ant Service Agreement with Central Exterminating Services, Inc. for the Town House. The cost for service for 2016 will be \$325.00.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to approve and execute the Carpenter Ant Service Agreement in the amount of \$325.00.

The Selectmen reviewed the 2016 Nobleboro/Jefferson Transfer Facility Contract in the amount of \$44,160.00 to be paid in 12 equal payments.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to approve and execute the Nobleboro/Jefferson Transfer Facility Contract in the amount of \$44,160.00.

The Selectmen reviewed the 2016 renewal contract for Marine Law Enforcement Services with the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office. This contract is identical to the 2015 contract.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to approve and execute the 2016 renewal contract for Marine Law Enforcement Services with the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office.

Selectman Nevins advised that the State of Maine will be performing light capital paving on Biscay and Turner Roads during 2016 and 2017.

The Selectmen discussed the Bremen Appeals Board. During the last meeting there was confusion as to who the members were and who the alternates were.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to appoint Gordon Lind and Melinda Wells as alternate Appeals Board members.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to approve the Warrants of 1/15/2016 and 1/22/2016.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to adjourn at 6:02 pm.
