Mary Voskian advised that the Town Center Project meeting went well. There was a good turnout of residents. There will be a final Town meeting on Tuesday, October 30, 2018 from 5:00 to 7:00 pm at the Town Center. The Committee will meet again in November to discuss the planner's information. The big issues are paying for the project and maintenance.

There will be a meeting of the Bremen Conservation Commission on October 25, 2018 at the Bremen Library regarding invasive plants.

Walter Voskian advised that there is a large agenda for the October 9<sup>th</sup> Planning Board meeting. The Planning Board had six official and unofficial inquires and has benefitted from Planning Board Consultant Bob Faunce.

Discussion regarding building permit fees and the consultant's role. It was determined that Bremen's present fees are low compared to other towns.

Bruce Johnston, Bremen Fire Department, was in attendance to bring the Selectmen up to date on the funds due from FEMA from the October 2017 windstorm.

Discussion regarding the Weston Memorial Spring with Town Attorney Meader.

The vandalism to the portable toilet at the Hay property was mentioned.

The condition of the Weston Cemetery was discussed. The ground is grub infested at this time and is caving in. This is also causing water runoff. The roots of the trees and bushes are growing under the headstones and tipping them over.


The condition of the clam flats at Broad Cove was discussed. The area is still being examined.
