

**TOWN OF BREMEN  
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES  
OCTOBER 19, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Selectman Nevins at 5:02 p.m.

Tom Kronenberger, Planning Board Co-Chair, advised that the Planning Board voted to increase the building permit fees to offset the cost of the Town Planner/Consultant. These fee increases are listed on the Bremen website.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept the Bremen Building Permit fee increases, effective 10/24/2017.***

The Planning Board also advised that they have finalized their request for the January through June 2018 budget.

Ann Nesslage advised that the Bremen Conservation Commission is very interested in working with the Town to build a playground and trail in the area of the Town Center.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Peter Goth, Ann Nesslage, Anna Barber, Judith Mohr, and Mary Sue Weeks as ballot clerks for the November 7, 2017 State Referendum Election.***

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Mary Sue Weeks, Walter Voskian, Joseph Vitti, Christopher Dickinson, Randy Cruz, Diana Blair-Monkman, and Sharon Adamsky as Budget Committee Members.***

The Selectmen received a resident's request for naming their road, which includes 2 or more residences. The resident suggested 3 names: Fairy Lane, Fairy Land Lane, or Fairy Woods Lane.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to reject the above three road names. The Selectmen proposed Johnston Hill Road or Fire Tower Road.***

The resident will be required to submit 3 additional names to the Selectmen for consideration.

The Selectmen distributed a sample Street Vendor Ordinance and requested the Planning Board review it.

The Selectmen and audience were reminded that the Bremen Budget Committee Meetings will be held on Monday, October 23, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. and Monday, October 30, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. (if necessary).

The Selectmen advised that 90% of the 2017 real estate taxes have been collected to date.

Selectmen Nevins advised that the Bremen First Responders have been very active with medical calls.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 10/05/2017.***


***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Warrants of 10/13/2017 and 10/20/2017.***
