

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 2, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 5:02 p.m.

Walter Voskian, Planning Board Chair, advised that the Planning Board has a light agenda for their November meeting as of this date.

Mary Voskian, member of Bremen Conservation Commission, advised the BCC will discuss their goal for the Land Use Reserve Fund. There is ongoing discussion regarding the grounds at the Town Center/Library location.

The Selectmen continued their discussion with a landowner regarding choice of road names.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the road name of Forest Way in the Town of Bremen. This approval is dependent on verification that no surrounding towns have the same name in the 911 system.

Bruce Johnston from the Bremen Fire Department gave an update on the power outages as a result of the recent windstorm. He indicated many roads were blocked. The Fire Department has been very busy since Monday morning fielding phone calls. They were opening roads from 5:30 am to 1:00 pm. On Monday, the Town was briefly inaccessible for mutual response and ambulance. Tuesday morning, they conducted welfare checks, called residents, and brought water via UTV. The Fire Department opened a warming shelter from 6:00 am to 9:00 pm offering showers, hot meals, and charging stations.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve Janice Kemper as an election clerk.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve and execute Auditor William Brewer's engagement letter.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve and execute a three-month agreement with Anne Krieg, Mid-Coast Regional Planning Commission, for consultant/planner services.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to set winter hours for the Bremen Town Center as follows:

January, February, March 2018 – open until 6:00 pm on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month only. The Town's regular schedule of open every Thursday until 6:00 pm will resume in April.


The Town received a thank you letter from Healthy Kids for their 2016 charitable contribution.




