

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 16, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 5:00 p.m.

Walter Voskian, Planning Board Chair, advised that the Planning Board has turned over the model vendor ordinance to our consultant. An alternate member of the Planning Board has resigned. The Board is now looking for 2 alternate members. The Town will send out an e-mail looking for volunteers as well as put an ad in the LCN.

Charles and Mallory Adams were in attendance to discuss the Town's rejection of their choice of road names. They were advised that the history of road naming in Bremen started with the 911 system. It is within the authority of the Select Board to choose road names in the Town. The Selectmen advised that their goal is to have a peaceful community and make the best decisions they can for all residents.

Terry Marsh, Bremen Conservation Commission, advised that Steve Wallace and Boe Marsh cleared the trail at the Bremen Town Forest after the wind storm. Terry advised that she and Christa Thorpe cleaned up bittersweet invasive plants throughout Town. There was a question as to how to dispose of these plants. Chairperson Pieh suggested contacting the Department of Agriculture.

Selectman Nevins advised that the recycling containers were removed from the Hay property. They were being used as trash containers. The Town will make arrangements for trash pickup in the spring.

The Town is still awaiting notice of the pre-construction meeting for the Heath Road Bridge. We will contact the parties again to schedule the meeting ASAP.

Selectman Nevins advised that the Town is working with FEMA for reimbursement from the recent wind storm. The Town hired Jody Sprague to push debris back from the roads. Jody has also taken photos to be supplied to FEMA. The Fire Department will be submitting the Town's request for reimbursement.

The Town received quotes for paving Rial Herald Road and the Fire Department parking lot. The Town will work with All States on the quotes. Shore Road will be chip sealed in 2019.

The Selectmen are working on new ordinances for marijuana, mobile vending, as well as a revised Appeals Board ordinance.

The removal and replacement of half of the siding on the Town Center will begin on November 28. The remainder, pending Town approval, will be completed in 2018.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 11/02/2017.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Warrants of 11/10/2017 and 11/17/2017.
