

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 19, 2015**

The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 3:00 pm.

The Selectmen requested the Bremen Harbor Master come to the meeting to gain information regarding the boat brought into Greenland Cove by Doug Wood. The Town and Harbor Master have received at least a dozen complaints from residents. Melanee was advised that Doug had permission to lay on someone else's mooring. That mooring could not be located, so Doug had a mooring set. There is a question as to the adequacy of the mooring for this vessel. The Town of Bristol paid Doug Wood to take the vessel, and Doug was to compensate the person who set the mooring.

Doug Wood planned to keep the vessel in Greenland Cove until spring. He is trying to gain ownership. If he cannot, he will scrap the vessel.

The Selectmen and Harbor Committee, as well as several residents, are concerned that the vessel will break loose and cause damage. The Harbor Master will set up a meeting for Friday, November 20 at 10:00 am to discuss this matter with Doug and the Town Attorney.

Bruce Poland suggested taking the vessel to a protected area like the Audubon. Melanee indicated, because of the weight, the vessel should be on two moorings. Melanee will ask the Coast Guard for assistance in determining if the mooring is adequate for the vessel.

Doug Wood will be contacted to attend a meeting on November 20 at 10:00 am.

Walter Voskian was in attendance to update the Selectmen on their last Planning Board Meeting.

The Assessors' Agent's contract for 2015 to 2020 was reviewed.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to accept and execute the Assessors' Agent's Contract for 2015 to 2020.


Selectman Nevins reviewed the Hay property progress. A quote for aluminum steps to the water will be obtained.




