

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 17, 2015**

Selectpersons present: Wendy Pieh, John Marsh, and Henry Nevins

The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 3:40 pm.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go into Executive Session at 3:40 pm pursuant to 1 MRSA § 405(6)(A) for personnel matters.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go out of Executive Session at 4:45 pm pursuant to 1 MRSA § 405(6)(A) for personnel matters.

The Selectmen's Meeting began again at 5:05 pm.

Discussed the FV Columbia with the Town Attorney. He advised that failure to obey the Harbor Master's orders are Class E crimes. An inadequate mooring is a civil violation. He advised that the Selectmen should wait until the decision is made by the Harbor Committee regarding Mr. Wood's Mooring Application.

Attorney Hull advised that the Bill of Sale provided by Mr. Wood appears legitimate. However, the vessel was deemed abandoned when it came into Bremen.

Selectman Nevins asked if the mooring is sufficient. Mr. Wood advised that the mooring was inspected by the Harbor Master and Bruce Poland and was approved. The new mooring is linked to the first mooring.

Mr. Wood advised that he can move forward now with insurance but needs a survey.

The question was asked how the vessel got from Pemaquid Harbor around Greenland Cove. The boat was towed. The question was asked if there was diesel in the vessel. Mr. Wood previously advised that there were no fluids in the boat.

Attorney Hull stated that public safety is a significant factor in approving moorings.




