

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 1, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 5:07 p.m.

Walter Voskian advised that the Planning Board has a short agenda for their next meeting. Walter advised that the Planning Board is still in need of two alternates.

The Selectmen discussed with Walter the need for a Recreational Vehicle Ordinance. The major concerns are health and safety and the length of time the RV stays on the property.

Mary Voskian, Bremen Conservation Commission, was present to discuss the Town Center property. She would like the exact amount of acreage and survey/boundary lines. The BCC is attempting to find a planner. BCC will look for grants as well.

Bruce Johnston, BVFD, was in attendance to update the Selectmen on the FEMA grant process regarding the windstorm. He attended a FEMA meeting on January 22. The BVFD's request for public assistance was accepted. FEMA will assign a project manager to review the expenses. This process may take six months. The latest request for reimbursement was approximately \$16,000. There is a possibility that 90% of the costs will be refunded.

The Selectmen reviewed a recent letter from Governor LePage regarding land taken off tax rolls for conservation, land trusts, etc. The Selectmen would like to prepare a letter of support and will get figures from the Town's Assessors' Agent.

Wendy Pieh advised of her progress attempting to locate a time capsule at the Bremen Town Center.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go in to Executive Session, pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel at 5:58 p.m.


