

**TOWN OF BREMEN  
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 15, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 5:00 p.m.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised that the Planning Board denied an application on Maple Lane that did not meet the setback requirements.

There was a discussion regarding reducing the members of the Planning Board to five. This will be pursued.

Mary Voskian, Bremen Conservation Commission, advised that Steve Laurich has volunteered to assist with bridge plans for the Bremen Town Forest. The Town Forest is in need of one ground bridge and two deck bridges. They proposed installing a sign-up sheet to gauge how many people are using the trail.

There was discussion about using ground penetrating radar to locate gravesites in the Quaker Cemetery.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to contract with Dig Smart of Maine to locate gravesites in the Quaker Cemetery using ground penetrating software.***

There was discussion regarding LD 1629 (the bill to protect the elderly from tax lien foreclosures). This bill would severely affect Bremen taxpayers. The Selectmen will contact Senator Dow to voice their opposition.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Town Clerk Cindi Hasty as Municipal Agent for the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.***


