

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
MAY 17, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 5:00 p.m.

Walter Voskian advised that at the Planning Board's meeting they approved a barn/garage on Turner Road with conditions and a lakeside cottage on Biscay Road with conditions. At the next meeting, they will be discussing the Planning Board Ordinance, By-Laws, and the Building in Bremen brochure.

Debbie Bridges from Maine Municipal Employees Health Trust was in attendance to discuss cost savings for Town health insurance. This would involve the Town establishing a Health Reimbursement Arrangement.

The Selectmen signed the Warrant for Hearing and Special Town Meeting in order to transfer \$30,000 from the Town's Undesignated Funds account to the Bremen Secondary Education Account. The Meeting will be held on Thursday, June 7, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.

The Selectmen discussed the proposal to join The Sheepscot Regional Service Center.

The All States contract for Rial Herald Road was discussed.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the option of fine grading then placing 2.5" of PMRAP base with a double latex modified chip seal surface on Rial Herald Road in the amount of \$112,070.40. This contract is contingent on Town approval at the Town Meeting to be held on July 21, 2018.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go into Executive Session at 5:57 p.m., pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to go out of Executive Session at 6:27 p.m., pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel.

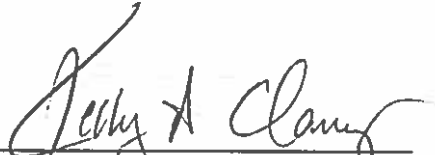
On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to advertise for a Planning Board Recording Secretary.
