***The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pieh at 5:06 p.m.***

Walter Voskian updated the Selectmen on Planning Board activities. He will be attending an MMA workshop on May 23. David West has resigned as alternate for the Planning Board, as he is also a member of the Appeals Board. June 13 is the next Planning Board meeting. Currently, there are 3 applications to consider at that meeting.

Christa Thorpe updated the Selectmen on Conservation Commission projects. Juanita Roushdy has resigned as Chairman. No new Chairman has been elected as yet. The Friends of Clam Island have mapped out a footpath on the island and will begin work soon. The BCC is continuing to work with landowners regarding the trail behind the post office. The BCC has voted not to pursue logging on the Town conservation properties. Hank advised that the parking spaces at Hillside Cemetery are now complete.

The Selectmen met with the engineer and DEP officials regarding the Heath Road Bridge. DEP felt positively about the salt marsh being protected by widening of the bridge. Calderwood Engineering will forward the corrected plan to DEP next week and will begin the bidding process for the bridge.

Clam conservation work was discussed. Boe will contact Hannah Annis to set a meeting at high tide for her to talk with the clam diggers regarding conservation.

The remaining side of the Town House will be completed next week with new cedar siding.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the contract with Mid-Coast Energy Systems to purchase a new 14KW generator in the amount of \$6,065.00.***

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the contract with AllStates Asphalt, Inc. for chip sealing in the amount of \$73,173.83.***

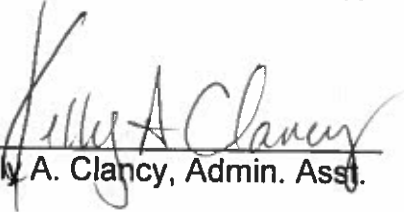

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 6:02 p.m.***

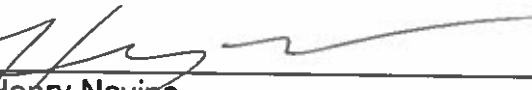
