

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
May 21, 2015**

On a motion duly made and seconded, the meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 5:03 p.m.

Ken Shapiro was in attendance to discuss his proposed private recreational pier on Greenland Island. He wanted to discuss it with the Selectmen and figure out what to do. Mr. Shapiro was advised to contact his attorney.

The Selectmen reviewed the bid from Hagar Enterprises for re-grading the Town roads.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the bid from Hagar Enterprises in the amount of \$3,887.00 for re-grading.

There was a brief discussion about the snowplow contract for our current contractor.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to contact our contractor, Jody Sprague, for a proposal to extend the contract.

The status of the Muscongus Club was discussed. For the Town to become involved, the decision would have to be made at a Town meeting after a public hearing.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to send a letter to Judith Mohr of the Muscongus Club seeking additional information.

All States Asphalt would not agree to 2% net 10; however, they did agree to postponing payment until mid October.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the All States Asphalt, Inc. contract with payment in October 2015.

The IPTV Franchise Agreement with Lincolnville was discussed. The Town of Bristol has just signed their agreement. The Selectmen will meet with the Town attorney at their next meeting to review the Agreement once again.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to send a letter of intent to record liens and foreclose to Gerald Anderson, Jr.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to sign the 2015 Lincoln County tax commitment in the amount of \$243,661.97.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the Warrants of 5/15/2015 and 05/22/2015.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to adjourn at 7:07 pm.


