

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 16, 2016**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pieh at 5:05 p.m.

Warren Livermore was in attendance to discuss the construction of steps at the Hay property. He has proposed a landing 6' wide and 2' out, anchored to the ground. The stairs would be 16' long with a 6" rise and a 1' wide tread. Handrails will be on both sides. The bottom will have a 6' by 6' landing which would meet the dirt path. The bottom stairs would be affixed to the landing. Next to the landing, there will be a 4' wide flat ramp with cleats that abuts the stairs. There will be a non-slip coating applied as well.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to hire Warren Livermore to construct the steps at the Hay Conservation and Recreation Area.

The proposed contract with the Eric Galant, consultant for Town Ordinances, was discussed. Attorney Hull has edited the contract. The Selectmen also made some edits.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the contract with Eric Galant if he agrees with the edits made by the Town attorney and Selectmen.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 06/02/2016.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the Warrants of 6/10/2016 and 6/17/2016.
