On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Francena A. Bennett and Mary Sue Weeks as Ballot Clerks.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Gordon Lind, as Alternate Planning Board member.


