

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
JULY 20, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pieh at 4:00 p.m.

The meeting began with a discussion about the 2017 tax commitment. The Selectmen, Auditor, and Assessors' Agent agreed that 2017 necessitates a slight increase in the mill rate to 12.8.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept 12.8 as the 2017 mill rate.

The regular Selectmen's Meeting began at 4:45 p.m. with a discussion regarding the Sheriff's report on speeding on Medomak Road. Also, chip sealing has been completed. The Town will solicit bids for paving the Fire Department lot next year. Trimming has also been completed. A ramp has been built at Hillside Cemetery at the entrance to the trail. The Town will work on further signage for parking.

Walter Voskian advised that the Planning Board's next meeting is scheduled for August 8 and an Appeals Board Hearing is scheduled for August 10.

Mary Voskian advised that the Conservation Commission's next meeting is scheduled for August 7 at 5:30 p.m. at the Bremen Library. There is a Music Haul concert scheduled for September 16 at 2:00 p.m. at the Bremen Town Center/Library location.

At 5:00 p.m. a Special Town Meeting to expend \$6,065.00 from undesignated funds to replace the Town generator began.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Wendy Pieh as moderator.

Article 2 was read aloud. There was no public comments.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to expend \$6,065.00 from undesignated funds to replace the Town generator.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to adjourn the Special Town Meeting at 5:05 p.m.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve application for pole location from Tidewater for a Bremen resident.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Douglas Jones as a member of the Bremen Board of Appeals.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Martha Varsano as an Associate Member of the Bremen Town House Committee.
