SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
JULY 21, 2016**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pieh at 4:10 p.m.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 07/07/2016.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted, unanimously, to approve the Warrants of 7/15/2016 and 7/22/2016.

The meeting began with a discussion with Town Auditor William Brewer and Town Assessors' Agent Jim Murphy regarding the 2016 tax commitment and mil rate.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept the mil rate of 12.6.

The Selectmen discussed with the Town Auditor the process for changing the Town's fiscal year.

Jim Murphy presented the Selectmen with a Supplemental Tax Warrant that was for a building that was omitted from taxation for the last 3 years.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to execute the Supplemental Tax Warrant.

Ken Shapiro was in attendance to discuss the clam flat problems in Greenland Cove. His property was visited by the Department of Agriculture and found to have no pollution problems.


The Selectmen discussed a complaint regarding loud chanting on Fogler Road. The Town CEO will check into this.


