

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 16, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 5:05 p.m.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, by proxy, advised that the Planning Board approved one application for expansion in the Commercial Fishing/Maritime District at its August meeting. The Planning Board Ordinance is near completion and will be sent to the Town attorney for review. Walter has been re-elected as Chairman of the Planning Board.

There was discussion regarding lack of Planning Board members as well as other Town boards and committees.

Mary Voskian, Bremen Conservation Commission, spoke about the meeting at the Town Center on September 19th from 6:00 to 8:00 pm to meet the planner for the Town Center Project. The planner will provide some ideas, sketches, and then have a question and answer period. Most of the comments from the survey the BCC sent out were positive. The project will be funded by grants, donations and fundraisers.

Selectman Nevins asked for an update from the Friends of Clam Island.

The Selectmen asked for a written opinion from the Bremen Conservation Commission regarding the Weston Memorial Spring on Fogler Road.

The Selectmen spoke about forming a Parks and Recreation Committee.

Selectman Nevins advised that Heath Road (from the bridge to Route 32) will be chip sealed. Rial Herald Road will also be chip sealed.

The contract for the fire alarm system for the Fire Department was discussed (see Article 47 of the Annual Town Report).

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept and move forward with the contract from Cunningham Security Systems for the fire alarm system for the Fire Department.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to sign a letter to FEMA regarding firefighter compensation.

The presentation of the Boston Cane plaque to Robert Goth will be made on August 23rd at 3:00 pm.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Emergency Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 8/13/2018.

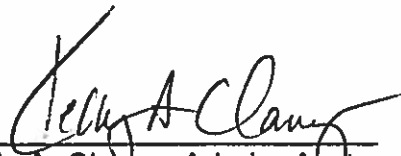
On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Warrants of 8/10/2018 and 8/17/2018.

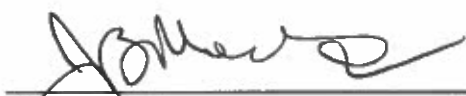

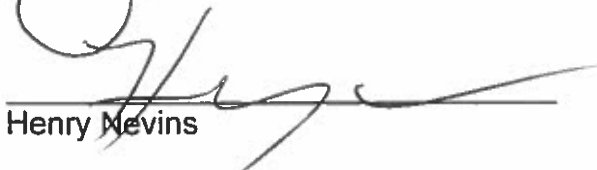
