

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 7, 2017**

Selectpersons present: Wendy Pieh, John Marsh, Henry Nevins

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pieh at 5:05 p.m.

The meeting began with the Residential Commercial Shellfish License Lottery. There were 12 applications received. All applications were inserted into a blank envelope and sealed by the prospective licensee.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to elect Maitland Williams to pick the envelopes for the lottery.

Chief Deputy Rand Maker, Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, acted as a witness to the integrity of the drawing and opened the sealed envelopes. Those chosen will have five (5) Bremen business days to purchase their shellfish license. The individuals must demonstrate that they have lived in Bremen for 180 days previous to the drawing.

Walter Voskian was in attendance to bring the Selectmen up to date on the schedule for the September 12th Planning Board meeting.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go into Executive Session at 5:28 p.m. pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(E) in regard to a legal matter and also 1 MRSA §405(6)(A) in regard to a personnel matter.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go out of Executive Session at 6:05 p.m. pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(E) in regard to a legal matter and also 1 MRSA §405(6)(A) in regard to a personnel matter.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to the approve the proposal of Anne Krieg, Mid-Coast Regional Planning Commission, to serve as Planning Board Consultant with modification of responsibilities to include: Review Planning Board applications for completeness and compliance, communicate with the applicant, Planning Board, and Town Attorney, preparation of report/plan with motions for Planning Board Meeting as well as attendance at said meeting.

Selectman Nevins advised that the DEP permit for the Heath Road Bridge has been signed. The Town is awaiting its receipt.

The sand shed at the Fire Department parking lot is in the process of being rebuilt, due to deterioration of its structure.

The Town's mowing contractor will trim bushes at the old Creek Road Town Landing. Once completed, Sprague Excavation will lay fabric and apply reclaim to the area.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to execute the Warrant for a Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting to enact General Assistance Ordinance Appendices A – D scheduled for September 21, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.


Selectman Nevins advised that he is working on a preliminary budget for the next Selectmen's Meeting.
