

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 17, 2015**

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 9:00 a.m.

Dale Smith, Deputy Fire Chief, Waldoboro was in attendance to obtain the Selectmen's Signature on the Mutual Aid Agreement between Bremen and Waldoboro.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to execute the Mutual Aid Agreement between Bremen Fire Department and Waldoboro Fire Department.

David Osier was in attendance to discuss his Working Waterfront Classification. The Selectmen will speak with the assessor's agent.

William Webber was in attendance to inquire about his daughter not being picked up by the school bus. He feels it is unsafe and unacceptable. The Selectmen agreed and will write the school superintendent.

Steve Barnes and Walter Voskian were in attendance to discuss Definitions and Ordinance Language, Draft Commercial and Industrial Application, Subdivision Ordinance Application, and Worksheet for Subdivision Ordinance. The Selectmen will forward this information to the Town Attorney for his review and comment.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Selectmen voted to endorse the Planning Board memo and send to the Town Attorney for a response within two weeks.

The Planning Board spoke with the Selectmen regarding hiring an assistant to filter through some of the requests prior to presenting to the Planning Board, as some other towns do. Selectman Marsh will make contact with an individual that Damariscotta uses.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to appoint Dr. William Emmet to the Planning Board for a term to conclude in 2018.

Selectman Nevins gave an update on the Bremen Town House. The exterior painting has been completed. The Town will look into replacing the exterior lighting.

The Town Center is presently soliciting bids for plumbing for renovation of the public bathrooms.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to approve the Special Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 6/25/2015.


