The Special Selectmen's Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pieh at 11:05 am.

The purpose of the meeting was to review, for clarification, the Hay Conservation and Recreation Area camp road proposals from Sprague Transport & Excavation, Inc. (\$49,139.00) and Ernest Poland (\$41,700.00).

The Selectmen specifically reviewed the equipment owned by the two bidders, how soon the job would be completed, the history of work with municipalities, and the price and payment schedule.


The Selectmen found that, although there was a difference in prices, Sprague's proposal was well outlined, contained all items to be used, and below budget. Sprague is also a known entity to the Town and possesses all the equipment needed to complete the job.

Mr. Sprague indicated he can begin the job in approximately 1-1/2 weeks, dependent on weather, and should take about 2 weeks to complete the project.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to approve the proposal from Sprague Transport & Excavation, Inc.


