

## About this Preserve

Pemaquid Pond Preserve in Bremen was donated to PWA by the Stock-Moody family in 2015. Their intent was to allow public enjoyment of this land on the shores of Pemaquid Pond while maintaining the natural state.

This preserve consists of 29 acres and a 1.9-acre island.

The primary conservation value is the shoreline which consists of rocky outcrops, sandy beaches and wooded shores. Along the shoreline, notice the prime examples of native vegetation that prevents erosion and protects the health of the pond. There are also wetlands, wooded uplands, and fern-filled glades. The only water access from the pond is at the end of the spur trail and at the island but not during loon nesting season, mid-May to mid-July.

### **Please follow these policies & enjoy your visit:**

*Preserve open only during daylight hours for hiking & other low-impact uses*

*Sign in at the kiosk*

*No motorized recreational vehicles*

*Well behaved dogs on leash are permitted*

*No overnight camping or fires*

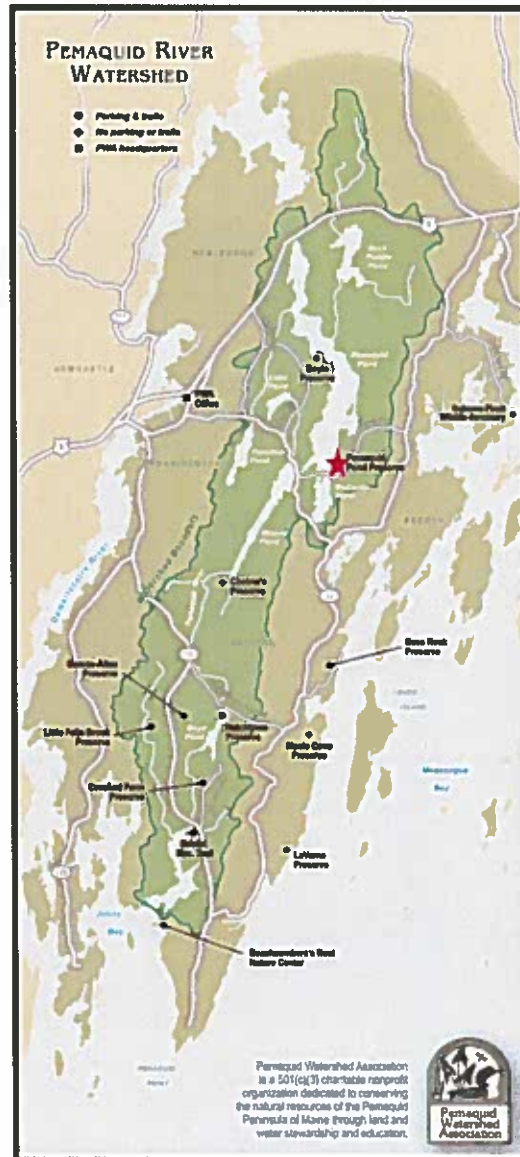
*Fishing is allowed in season*

*No hunting*

*Stay on trails & respect private property; do not go beyond preserve boundary markers*

*Leave No Trace: carry out what you bring in*

**DIRECTIONS:** From Business Rt. 1 in Damariscotta, turn onto Biscay Road at the traffic light (by McDonalds). Travel 3 miles and just after Biscay Pond, turn left on to Turner Road. Follow Turner Road, cross the causeway between Pemaquid Pond & McCurdy Pond, continue about 0.6 miles, see the preserve sign on the left and the small parking lot entrance.
