

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 21, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m.

Christa Thorpe acknowledged a letter written to the Bremen Conservation Commission by the Selectmen requesting they elect a chair. The BCC will discuss this at their March meeting.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised that the Planning Board meeting for February was cancelled due to the weather as well as having no quorum. At their March meeting they will attempt to wrap up the Planning Board Bylaws.

Walter Voskian, Bremen representative for the Lincoln County Regional Planning Commission, advised that he met the new planner, Megan McLaughlin.

The Selectmen indicated they would speak with the Town Attorney regarding possible easements for Marble Road for snowplowing and a school bus turnaround.

The Selectmen also indicated there is a necessity to form a ditch on Shore Road at Will Butler Lane to handle runoff.

The Selectmen discussed starting a reserve fund for the Town's 2028 Anniversary at \$1,000/year. This will be discussed with the budget committee.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go in to Executive Session at 5:40 p.m. pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go out of Executive Session at 6:05 p.m. pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel.

The Town Office received notice that the newly hired Deputy Clerk decided not to take the position. The Town will follow up with another applicant.

The Selectmen requested scheduling a clam harvester meeting on March 7 at 11:00 a.m. followed by a Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting at Noon. The Clam Committee will meet at 10:30 a.m. on March 7.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 2/07/2018.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Warrants of 2/15/2019 and 2/22/2019.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 6:25 p.m.


