Steve Barnes was in attendance to discuss the Storer Road landing. He will prepare the Army Corps of Engineers application for permit and submit it to the Town Office. The Town will also prepare a Permit By Rule and send to DEP.

Ann Nesslage, Bremen Conservation Commission, advised that they will review the BCC Bylaws at their next meeting. She also inquired about repairing/replacing the fencing around the ballfield. Ann received an inquiry regarding moving the bench at the Heath Road Bridge to a more scenic location.

Selectman Nevins advised that the Town has hired a contractor to catch the beavers on Rial Herald Road that are blocking the culvert.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to sign the Animal Control Services contract with the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office to begin July 1, 2019.

The Midcoast Humane Society Agreement was reviewed. Further information will be gathered prior to signing.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to appoint Stanley Waltz as Code Enforcement Officer for the fiscal year July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to sign the Assessors' Abatement correcting ownership of two parcels.


