

**TOWN OF BREMEN

The meeting was called to order at 4:40 p.m.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised there were no applications at the last Planning Board meeting. The Planning Board approved their final draft of the Building in Bremen Brochure.

Selectman Nevins advised that the Hay Conservation & Recreation Area will be bush hogged during the first week of October. The portable toilet will be removed at the end of October. Culverts will be replaced on Fogler Road during the next week. This will be published in The Lincoln County News and signs will be installed on the road.

All municipalities received notification from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles regarding increased municipal agent fees and motor vehicle fees.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to increase the agent fees and motor vehicle fees according to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles memorandum with an effective date of September 19, 2019.

Selectman Marsh advised that he and Town Clerk Melanie Pendleton attended a meeting at the Town of Damariscotta regarding their shellfish resilience study. Selectman Marsh also conveyed information regarding Damariscotta's work on LED street lights and their marijuana ordinance.


