

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 15, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

Floyd Gent, Bremen Planning Board, advised they considered two applications at their last meeting and approved a new home and a dock (with some conditions) as well as approved steps to access a dock on Biscay Pond. They also had an informal consultation regarding a property on Shore Road as a bed and breakfast. The Planning Board has completed their work on the Building in Bremen brochure and requests review by the Selectmen.

LED lighting incentives from The Nature Conservancy were discussed. Through the application process, it was discovered that, although it was advertised as being an incentive for small communities, the Town of Bremen does not qualify because of hours of occupancy.

The funds for the solar power project were discussed. The Town will hold a Special Town Meeting for a vote.

The proposed Shoreland Zoning Ordinance continues to be under review by the Ordinance Review Committee.

The Town had a request from a resident for a drop box at the Town Center. This will be reviewed.

Fogler Road is currently undergoing culvert replacements. Ditching will also be done. Another culvert will be replaced on Nobleboro Road.

High speed internet service was discussed. The Town's proposal from Tidewater (Lincolnvile) has unreasonable terms. The Broadband Committee will continue to work on this.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go in to Executive Session, pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel at 5:15 p.m.


