

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 7, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 5:04 p.m.

Ernest Carroll was in attendance to discuss the broadband negotiations with LCI. The committee is awaiting a new proposal from LCI.

Selectman Nevins gave an update on the roads. The Town is awaiting an estimate from All States for chip seal for Shore Road. He stated moving the equipment and labor are the largest costs.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept the \$2,000 ASK grant received from the Lincoln County Regional Planning Commission for planning services for a recreation/play area proposed by the Bremen Town Project Committee.

The hours the Fire Department put in for the October wind storm were discussed. The firemen cleaned up debris on the roads and manned the warming center for over 200 hours.

During the wind storm, the power supply was pulled from the Town Office exterior wall by a downed tree which broke the power pole.

There is a CLC Ambulance meeting on November 12. Selectman Nevins will attend.


Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised that the PB has one item on their agenda for November 12, which is an informal discussion.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 10/15/2019.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Warrants of 10/18/2019, 10/25/2019, 11/01/2019 and 11/08/2019.


