

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 21, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised that he and Alternate Member Autumn Mahoney attended the Spirit of America Awards wherein the Planning Board received their award, nominated by the Town of Bremen. He stated it was a team effort which demonstrated Bremen volunteerism.

Walter advised that the next Planning Board meeting includes an informal discussion and final review of the Building in Bremen Brochure, which was approved by the Board of Selectmen.

Mary Voskian, Bremen Town Project Committee, advised that she had a meeting with the prospective planner. Mary also indicated the group is working on a grant from the Maine Bicentennial Commission. The Committee will pick a date in August for the Town celebration.

Ann Nesslage, Bremen Conservation Commission, advised that they are compiling a list of Town properties and Town trails. They will be working on the kiosks at the Town Forest and the Hay property. The Committee is having difficulty with membership. The Town will research the required number of members to vote and act on Committee matters.

The audience was reminded that there will be a Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting on December 12, 2019 at 6:00 pm.

Properties out of compliance with Town ordinances were discussed. The Town Code Enforcement Officer has sent out certified letters to those property owners.

The engineer's report for the solar panels on the Fire Department was reviewed. The roof will require additional supports.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the 2020 Marine Law Enforcement Services Contract with the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office was unanimously approved and signed by the Selectmen.

The Selectmen were presented with a request to name a road off of Route 32. The property owner suggested Seamus Road, Katie Lane, or Brigadoon Lane.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Selectmen voted unanimously that all three names are acceptable.

The homeowner will advise the Town on their final choice for the road name.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept the proposal for a new computer complete with Windows 10 in the amount of \$879.00.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted two (2) yes and one (1) recuse, to increase the Firemen and First Responder hourly pay to \$20.00 effective January 1, 2020.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go in to Executive Session, pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel at 6:18 p.m.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to go out of Executive Session, pursuant to 1 MRSA §405(6)(A), personnel at 6:47 p.m.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 11/07/2019.
