

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 6, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m.

Mary Voskian, Bremen Town Project Committee, advised that she and Anne Stires, Jupiter Hill School (planner), walked the site of the proposed recreation/playground area. She indicated she needed the Town property line on the north side. The Committee is still looking into funds for the Town Bicentennial Celebration. The Committee has picked the date of August 8, 2020 as the Celebration date.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised that the Planning Board had an informal discussion regarding construction of a seasonal residence on McCurdy Road. They will conduct a final review of the Building in Bremen brochure. Walter advised the Board is now down to 5 members.

Ann Nesslage, Bremen Conservation Commission, advised that they are pursuing members to serve on the Commission.

The Selectmen were presented with a Supplemental Tax Warrant for property that was omitted from taxation for the 2019-2020 fiscal year in the amount of \$491.52 due to a program error.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to accept the Supplemental Tax Warrant for in the amount of \$491.52 for the fiscal year 2019-2020.

Assessors' Agent Jim Murphy requested authority to make baseline building valuations then to lakefront land valuations to result in the equitable treatment of all property owners.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to advise the Assessors' Agent to go forward with adjusting baseline building valuations then to lakefront land valuations to result in the equitable treatment of all property owners.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Warrants of 11/29/2019 and 12/06/2019.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 5:42 p.m.


