The Town finances were discussed. This budget cycle should be ok. Secondary education is up \$43,000. It is suspected we will lose our State-funded local road assistance as well as revenue sharing.

The Town will contact the Bremen Conservation Commission to review the possible purchase/donation of property on Webber Pond with the other members. We will ask what the best use for the property should be; strictly conservation or public.


The possibility of rescheduling the Town Meeting to July 18 was discussed.

***On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to adjourn at 12:00 Noon.***


