On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to drop the land purchase based on Town budget planning.


Discussed the Planning Board application process. It is the request of the Town office staff to keep the submission deadline on Wednesday at Noon.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to postpone the lien notices for a minimum of 30 days.


On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 2:20 p.m.


