

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 18, 2020**

The meeting was called to order at 11:10 a.m.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised that the Planning Board will conduct their July 14th PB meeting via zoom.

Walter reiterated his concern regarding speeding on Route 32. Speeding appears to have increased with a lot of heavy trucks. Chairperson Pieh had previously written to the State regarding this issue and will follow up.

Ann Nesslage, Bremen Conservation Commission, advised that the BCC had recently met. They have noticed individuals picking flowers at the Hay property. Next year they will think about signage to deter this. Ann advised that next Saturday there will be a trail day. Ann advised that Daniel Ungier is no longer a member of the BCC; she will attempt to get this in writing for Town records.

Matthew Hanly was in attendance to discuss the nationwide initiative that all communities examine their use of force in policing situations. Matthew will meet with Sheriff Brackett next week to discuss. Pastor Char Corbett, Sarah Wineberg, and Cristina Stirrat were in attendance to support these efforts.

Sandra Thomas was in attendance to discuss Shore Road. She stated the grading was ok but was concerned about how far paving is going. Selectman Nevins indicated the cold flex paving was going 1600 feet on both sides. Next year the Town will chip seal the paved area only. Chairperson Pieh indicated that our contractor stated this is what the Town needs to do to protect the road.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted unanimously to approve the Animal Control Services contact with the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office.
