

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 20, 2020**

The meeting was called to order at 5:07 p.m.

Walter Radloff asked why he did not see any clammers. Selectman Marsh advised that Broad Cove has been closed due to bacteria.

The Selectmen were asked about assisting a homeowner with installation of utility poles on Shore Road. This is the responsibility of the homeowner, not the Town.

Walter Voskian, Bremen Planning Board, advised that he attended a Lincoln County Regional Planning Commission meeting. The LCRPC indicated that they are eager to receive the requested needs assessment from the Town. This will be completed and returned. Walter indicated the Planning Board met on August 11 via zoom. They had 5 applications; 3 applications were deferred to September's meeting. Walter also inquired about results from the Route 32 speed study. Chairperson Pieh will look into this.

Ann Nesslage, Bremen Conservation Commission, advised that Daniel Ungier has formally resigned from the Commission.


