The tax commitment date is set for Wednesday, July 23 @ 11:00 am here at the town center. There will be an ad placed in the LCN and is open to the public.

Road Commissioners, Papell and Adkins gave information on the stripping on the parking area here at the town center. There will be 1 handicap space running parallel with the ramp. The number of handicapped spaced required is determined by the number of parking spaces, for 1-25 there is only 1 space required and once the stripping is completed there will be 21-23 potential spots.

Motion made by Selectman Marsh to have a letter drafted by our attorney to relinquish the town easement for the snowplow and bus turn around on Marble Road. Second by Selectman Papell, so vote 3-0.

Chair Pieh would like to Thank Deb Elliott for the outstanding work that she did in baking and collecting donated items for the Waldoboro Food Pantry. The trunk of her car is full and she has \$355 for the Pantry.

Ann Nesslage, BCC, the pamphlets for the invasive plants will be scanned and the emailed out To the community. Invasive project is in progress as is the bog bridge work. Hay property Erosion is a concern and will be a future discussion. The picnic table is being delivered to the Hay property.

Selectman Marsh announced that there will be Shellfish meeting on Wednesday, July 16 at 2:00 pm to discuss the reclassification of Broad Cove. This reclassification closes the cove from June 30<sup>th</sup> to October 31. 14 clear water tests necessary to get re-classified. No cause has been determined at this time and currently working with DMR and possibly Coastal Rivers to determine what caused the issue.
