Sharon Marchi of the Bremen Library discussed the development of the Town property, this

being the ballfield and the upper lawn area across from the library. Selectman Papell and Marsh both explained that at this time the town is working with the Lincoln County Little League on gathering estimates for re-establishing the ballfield for use. The project had been discussed at previous board meetings and would potentially have an informational gathering meeting later in the winter with the town residents as to how they would like to see the field being used. Max Johnstone had been on site and walked the field area; he will be working with the town as to potential grant opportunities once a better scope of what the residents would like to see for the field use. Sharon expressed that the library would like to collaborate with the town as to walking trails between the two properties. Ann Nesslage also expressed that the BCC would like

to see about having handicapped assessable trails if possible.

The upper lawn area would then be, potentially, an additional parking area. This would be a second phase, or down the road type of item according to both Selectmen Marsh and Papell due to

budgeting.
